



WEEE Compliance Statement

Cardwave is committed to meeting all legal requirements of the The Waste Electrical Electronic and Equipment Regulations 2013, and is registered for WEEE Compliance under the compliance number **WEE/CJ4840YQ**

The WEEE directive requires that manufacturers of electrical and electronic equipment who sell into EU countries: (1) label their equipment to notify customers that it needs to be recycled, and (2) ensure that their products are appropriately disposed of or recycled at the end of their lifespan.

The definition of a WEEE product is one whose primary function is dependent on electrical currents to carry out the main function, e.g. a fence energiser. However, some products, are not classed as WEEE as its primary function is something else. Further information is available at:

Such products are marked with the "crossed-out wheelie bin" WEEE symbol in accordance with European Standard EN50419.

Any Cardwave branded products that are held by private households should be recycled via your local collection facilities. Details of these should be obtained from your local authority.

Any products supplied to business customers should be disposed of appropriately to meet the WEEE EU directive where applicable.

Cardwave will ensure the proper recycling of waste arising from any Cardwave branded product arising at our customers (other than private households) within the United Kingdom on a like-for-like basis.
